#### DA Tips and Tricks

Did you know that DeviceAnywhere automatically stores the last 100 frames of device activity? Just like a Tivo, it keeps a cache of LCD frames, which are then deleted when you switch to a new device.

▶ You can view these past frames using the Video Controls that appear just under the handset in DeviceAnywhere Studio. These controls include rewind, fast forward, and play.

▶ You can also change the number of frames that are cached by selecting File -> Options in the menu bar.
