DA Tips and Tricks

Did you know that you can upload your mobile applications to your MyDeviceAnywhere account and then download them to DeviceAnywhere devices for testing? The My Applications tab in MyDeviceAnywhere allows you to store and manage mobile applications. To Upload to My Applications, follow this procedure:

1. In a browser, log in to your MyDeviceAnywhere account.
2. Click the My Applications tab.
3. Click the Add Application icon at the top of the page.
4. Enter the application name and type.
5. Click Save.
6. Click Add/Remove files.
7. Click Add file. A browser opens enabling you to navigate to the folder where the application is located on your computer.
8. Click Save. Your mobile application is uploaded to your MyDeviceAnywhere account.

Note: When uploading, make sure to include the Jad and Jar files, or any other files required by your application.

You can then download mobile applications to DeviceAnywhere handsets over-the-air by doing the following:

1. Navigate to the URL entry field on the device.
2. Make sure the field is entirely blank. Delete characters if necessary.
3. Click GoTo My Applications (bottom icon) of the On-Screen Icons next to the device. This feature automatically enters the My Applications URL into the field.
4. Click the Navigate to Application button.
5. Click OK or Yes to navigate to the URL.
