### DA Tips and Tricks

Did you know predictive text can affect the characters input when using your keyboard?

Predictive text is also known as T9, Smarttext, Primary input, or ABC text.

When text errors or duplicated letters appear on the screen, predictive text may be affecting your keyboard input. In this case, navigate to the Text Input settings and either set your device to regular ABC text or turn off predictive text.

DeviceAnywhere now offers a hardware control to manipulate a device accelerometer. The hardware control supports three orientations: 90 degrees right, 90 degrees left, and straight up. This functionality is currently supported on the majority of the iPhones in US packages, with other devices coming soon.
