DA Tips and Tricks

There are a number of predictive text entry modes being supported on new devices. Some examples include MultiTap, iTap, and Samsung Type, to name a few.

These entry modes can interfere when using either keyboard text entry or the Copy & Paste command to enter data into DeviceAnywhere handsets. For keyboard entry or Copy & Paste to work correctly, any predictive text entry features must be turned off on the device.

If you get garbled text when typing on your keyboard or while using Copy & Paste to enter data, check that any predictive text modes are disabled on the device.




