DeviceAnywhere 5.0 is Here!

Today DeviceAnywhere 5.0 was deployed. We've highlighted some of the new features and provided a short description of them below. DeviceAnywhere Tips and Tricks

New in 5.0: Creating a Device List

Ever wished that you could easily find the short list of devices that you plan to test against? That the rest of the 2000+ devices were hidden so you could quickly pinpoint your favorites?

The new device list feature offers just that capability. To begin:

1. Create a Project (the container for a device list) by selecting By Project instead of By Package in the filter area at the top of the device list panel in Studio.
2. Click on the link to create a new project.
3. Enter a name for your project and select Create. It will take a few moments for the project to be created.
4. The project properties add devices dialog will open. Select devices from the left and click Add to include them in your project.
5. Select Save.

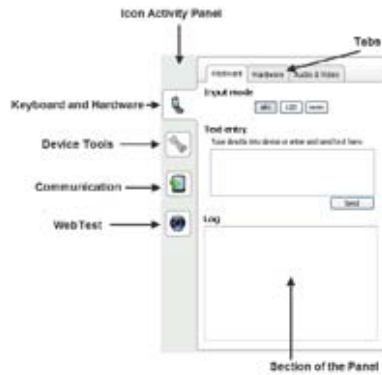
Now you have created your own device list, and when you select your project from the By Project drop down, only the devices you added to the project will show.

You can also use the new search functionality on the MyDeviceAnywhere website to find devices by feature and then add them to a project from the website. Note that the project must already be created within Studio before you can add devices to it from the website.

Resources

Updated UI

DeviceAnywhere Studio has a new look! The right-click menu was getting a little busy, so we created a new panel called the Device Console. There you can send text to the device, change your key mode, load applications, send SMS's to the device, change your hardware configuration, edit video and audio settings, establish a virtual connection, and more!



Device Specs

You will be able to view 50+ features of each device, including OS version, user agent string, firmware version, and whether features such as GPS, Wi-Fi, MMS, Accelerometer, etc. are supported.



Finding Devices

With the number of devices constantly growing, it has become difficult to find the device you want. With 5.0, the following new features are available to help you quickly get to the desired devices:

1. You can filter devices in Studio by typing text either from the manufacturer or model name into the Search Filter. The device panel will dynamically update to show only the devices that match the text.
2. You can add your favorite devices to a Project, and thus create your own device list(s). See the Tips and Tricks section of this newsletter to learn how!



Device Alerts

Now you can be automatically alerted as DeviceAnywhere adds new devices. Users can sign up for alerts by package, so that you only get emails about the devices you care about.



Test Case Manager

DeviceAnywhere Studio will have a new module where users can create test cases and then test against these cases across required devices. Studio will keep track of your progress (e.g. which devices are done). All status of tests and detailed screen shots are saved and compiled into easy-to-view reports in a new web reporting portal.

Test Automation

Customers interested in test automation will see many new features available in DeviceAnywhere Test Automation, including mixed manual and automated test capabilities, a Java editor available within Studio, and much more.
