## Dear DeviceAnywhere Users,

DeviceAnywhere, the service providing access to 2000+ handsets, is now known as the DeviceAnywhere Test Center. We decided to make this change for two reasons. Second, while the core functionality of DeviceAnywhere (now DeviceAnywhere Test Center) is not changing, the vision for the product is to add more features that streamline the entire mobile content testing and certification process, such as Proof Center (recently launched through our partner OpenMarket) and the Test Case Manager (coming this fall). So adding the words "Test Center" is also representative of the future direction of the product.

## DA Tips and Tricks

It's almost August, and at DeviceAnywhere we are gearing up for what is typically our busiest time of year - late summer through fall when the rush of new phones and content planned for the holidays increases the demand for device time.

In this busy season, you may find that a handset you need is being used by another. The following DeviceAnywhere Test Center features were designed to facilitate access to the handsets you need when you need them.

### Wait for Device

To automatically acquire a device you need once it becomes free:

1. Right click on the device icon and select Access Device, Wait for Device.
2. Select whether you want to automatically acquire the device when available, or merely be notified of its availability.
3. When the device becomes available, it will either automatically become acquired by you, or you will be notified and you can accept or reject the device.

### Reservations








To reserve a device at a future time:

1. Right click on the device and choose Reserve Device.
2. A website will appear where you can schedule your reservation.

Lastly, DeviceAnywhere Test Center often has multiple copies of popular devices. Make sure to check whether the same or a similar model is available.
