## DeviceAnywhere Now Supports GPS Testing

DeviceAnywhere has recently installed GPS repeaters in our US data center, to enable better testing of location-based applications. ## New Feature: vUSB

DeviceAnywhere is offering a Beta program to interested developers to try out a new feature: vUSB. This feature creates a virtual connection from your computer to your selected DeviceAnywhere device, enabling upload or download of mobile applications or content to a remote device, and/or establishment of two-way communication to interact with a device through IDE debug and development tools.

In return for signing up for this program, you will get free access to a special package with over 20 vUSB-enabled devices, and 10 FREE hours of use in that package. ### DA Tips and Tricks

Have you ever wanted to share your test results with a member of your team in real time?

You can do this in DeviceAnywhere Studio, using the Share Device feature.

To start a Share Device session:

1. Right click on your acquired device, and select Share Device from the menu. The Share dialog is displayed.
2. Click Generate Code. The code is a session ID.
3. Enter the email address of the team member who will join in a shared session.
4. Click Send. An email is sent to the your team member, which includes instructions on how to share in the live session and the code that is used to log in.

To log in to a Share Device session:

1. You will receive an invitation to view a Shared Device via email, containing a code.
2. Select View from the menu bar in DeviceAnywhere Studio.
3. Select Devices Available for Monitoring. This selection opens a dialog to log into the live session.
4. Enter the code.
5. Click Yes to confirm.
