Coming Soon - DeviceAnywhere 5.0!

Next month, the latest version of DeviceAnywhere will be available. As a quick preview, here are just a few of the new features you will see:

Device Specs: you will be able to view 50+ features of each device, including OS version, user agent string, firmware version, and whether features such as GPS, Wi-Fi, MMS, Accelerometer, etc. are supported. In addition, you can search by these features (on the website) to create your own specialized device lists, and import these lists into DeviceAnywhere Studio so you can easily select and test against only the devices you are interested in!

Device Alerts: Users can sign up for alerts by package, so they are immediately informed of new devices available in the Device Bank.

Test Case Manager: DeviceAnywhere Studio will have a new module where users can create test cases and then test against these cases across required devices. Studio will keep track of your progress (which devices are done). All status of tests and detailed screen shots are saved and compiled into easy-to-view reports.

Stay tuned for a special newsletter in a few weeks that will highlight all of the new functionality in DeviceAnywhere 5.0!

DA Tips and Tricks

For Android developers: this month's tip shows some options for transferring your app to an Android device.

DeviceAnywhere provides a webserver where you can store and download your applications. To use this webserver (called My Applications):

1. Log into your DeviceAnywhere account at www.deviceanywhere.com
2. Select My Applications
3. Upload your application to My Applications by selecting "Add Application", and follow the directions to add your app
4. Then go to the browser on the device, and navigate to the My Applications URL (you can paste this link into your device by clicking on the My Apps icon to the right of the device).
5. Browse to select your application and download your APK file.

Coming soon in 5.0:

You will be able to load applications onto devices directly through DeviceAnywhere Studio, without visiting the MyDeviceAnywhere website! Most devices will offer two options. The first is to upload your application to our webserver (all done within DeviceAnywhere Studio) and then download it via the provided url. The second option is to send the device an SMS with a link to your application. More information will be available on these new capabilities in a few weeks.
