DA Tips and Tricks

For those interested in developing applications for Sprint (Nextel) iDEN phones, the following carrier-provided procedure is the method that must be used to get your apps on Sprint iDEN phones:

1. Acquire the device that you would like to send your app to
2. From your PC browser, go to the iDEN Content Uploader website: <http://144.230.114.35/adp1/FUN/index.jsp>
3. Upload the application and enter the phone number of the device you would like to send your app to
4. Click Upload Application
5. When the device gets an SMS notification of a new file to download, open the message and click on the link in the SMS to initiate the download

Note: if you have any issues with this process, verify the phone number of the device.
